MIRAVALLES VOLCANO

As one of Costa Rica's most active volcanoes, Miravalles stands at 6,653 feet and is known for gas emanations and geysers utilized in a government geothermal project for electricity production. The journey showcases rolling hills and passes by a geothermal plant near the volcano. Miravalles, a dormant volcano, holds protected status due to its tropical vegetation and geological features, including steam spewing fissures, sulfur springs, and bubbling mud pools. A geothermal energy plant at Las Hornillas, located in an underground reservoir, converts steam to electricity and is open for visits.

Upon reaching the facility, a short tractor or horseback ride leads to hanging bridges and an easy hike to a waterfall. Explore steaming fumaroles and crystal formations before relaxing in thermal pools with warm mud. After the rejuvenating experience, shower and change in provided dressing rooms before your return trip to your Beach Hotel.

PALO VERDE

The thrilling 2-hour descent ends with a snack, and after a scenic drive back, a hot lunch awaits at the restaurant, complemented by restroom and changing facilities.

The Tenorio River adventure includes various challenges, including a unique 12-foot drop (class V), though its availability depends on weather and water levels. Participants can choose to skip any section exceeding their comfort level. This magical journey down the river unfolds amidst incredible wildlife and breathtaking scenery, promising an unforgettable experience for all.



The dive sites are formations of volcanic rock with corals. His dive profile is multilevel diving, can be made in free descents and online reference, currents are to be found moderate to nil. The visibility is between 25 and 50 feet with a temperature of between 70 and 85 ° F. Its maximum depth is 80 feet. The minimum licensed required for this tour is: Scuba Diver or PADI Open Water Diver or its equivalent (SSI, NAUI, FEDAS).
